## What is SCRIP?

- ❖ Scrip is a term, which means, "substitute money".
- ❖ When you purchase Scrip, you receive negotiable gift certificates that are used like cash.

## Why use SCRIP?

- ❖ Scrip provides a means of raising money without asking anyone to spend a penny more than they already do.
- ❖ Scrip gives you the opportunity to contribute money to your school/group while making your normal purchases.
- ❖ Money that will be spent anyway is generating financial support that can provide enrichment programs and activities for your children.

## What can I purchase with SCRIP?

- ✓ Weekly groceries.
- ✓ Car washes and gasoline.
- ✓ Restaurant meals.
- ✓ Dry cleaning.
- ✓ Just about anything you need.

## Does it matter what form of payment I use?

SCRIP may be purchased by check, cash, or money order.

## How do I order SCRIP?

Order forms are sent home weekly with the students.

After looking through the list, select the certificates you would like to purchase. Return your completed [order form](#) with payment to school Monday morning. Your certificates will be returned to you in a laminated envelope on Friday. Return the envelope with your next order. You may order every week or only the weeks convenient for you.

## How does the school earn money?

The gift certificates (Scrip) are sold to us at a discounted rate.

We purchase them locally and through a national supplier.

We re-sell them to you at face value.

The difference is the amount the school earns.

## Is there anything else I should know about Scrip?

Yes. The SCRIP order form will change often. Some certificates may be added or dropped. The amount of profit may change. Please contact your building Scrip coordinator or the District Coordinator with any questions.
